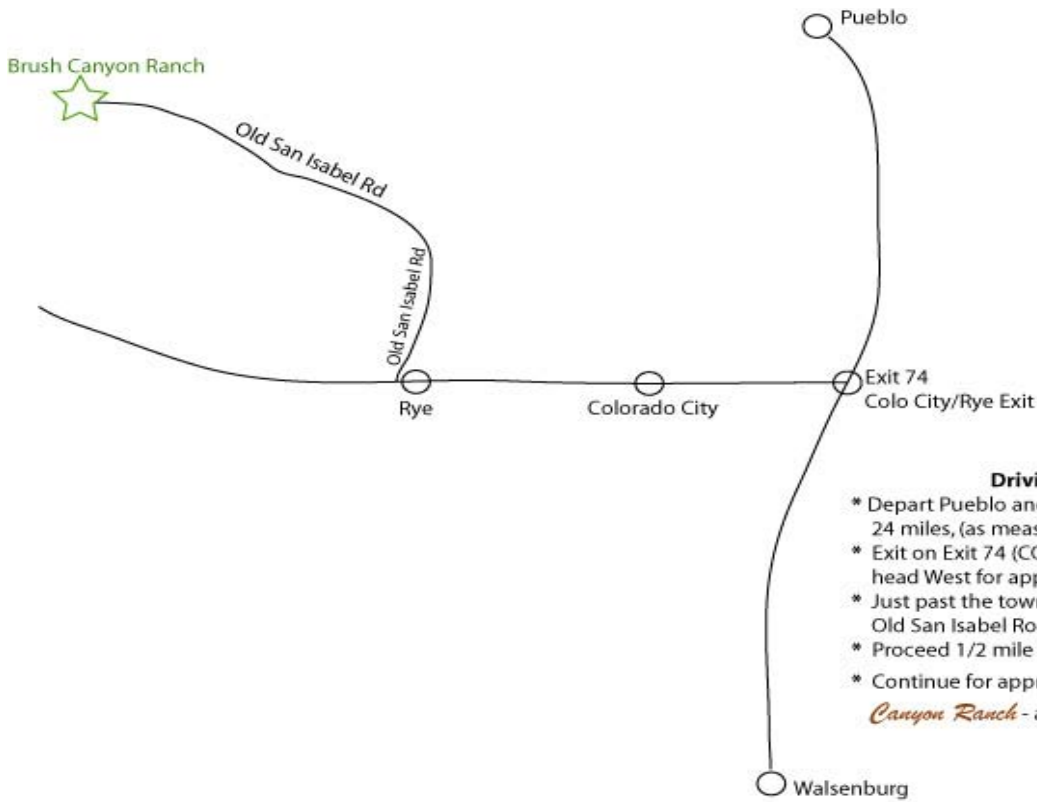
Annual Emmaus of the Rockies Picnic

- * Depart Pueblo and head South on I-25 for approx 24 miles, (as measured from center of town).
- * Exit on Exit 74 (CO-165/Colo City/Rye Exit) and head West for approx 9.1 miles.
- * Just past the town of Rye (1/3 mile), turn Right on Old San Isabel Road.
- * Proceed 1/2 mile and bear Left where the road turns.
- * Continue for approx 4 miles and turn Left into *Brush Canyon Ranch* - and have fun!
